

EXHAUST INSTALLATION #315513

WHEN INSTALLING THIS EXHAUST SYSTEM, MAKE SURE TO USE THE PROPER SAFTEY PRECAUTIONS. USE JACK STAND WHEN UNDER TRUCK, SET PARKING BRAKE, BLOCK TIRES, AND USE SAFTEY GLASSES AND GLOVES. **DO NOT WORK WITH HOT PIPES!**

SUGGESTED TOOLS:

15mm SOCKET, 9/16" SOCKET, $\frac{1}{2}$ " SOCKET, $\frac{1}{2}$ ' WRENCH, JACK STAND, WD-40, HACKSAW

LAY OUT THE EXHAUST AND COMPARE PART NUMBERS WITH THE DRAWING.



TO REMOVE STOCK
EXHAUST- UNBOLT IT FROM
THE TWO-BOLT FLANGE
LOCATED BEHIND THE STOCK
CATALYTIC CONVERTER.

YOU WILL REUSE YOU STOCK FLANGE

BOLTS.NOW CUT OFF YOUR STOCK TAILPIPE JUST BEHIND THE MUFFLER AND REMOVE. LEAVE ALL RUBBER GROMMETS ON THE HANGER. USE WD-40 TO AID IN REMOVAL OF EXHAUST AND HANGERS.



SLIDE OVERAXLE TAILPIPE #C INTO MUFFLER AT LEAST 1"- 2". THE TAILPIPE END THAT GOES INTO THE OUTLET OF THE MUFFLER HAS THE LONGEST WELDED HANGER. SLIDE WELDED HANGERS INTO RUBBER GROMMETS. USE CLAMP #F TO SECURE PIPE TO MUFFLER. DO NOT TIGHTEN.



BOLT HEADPIPE #A ONTO STOCK FLANGE RE-USING FACTORY BOLTS AND GASKET # G. INSERT WELDED HANGER INTO RUBBER GROMMET. DO NOT TIGHTEN. USE CLAMP #F TO SECURE MUFFLER TO HEADPIPE. DO NOT TIGHTEN



INSTALL TURNOUT # D PIPE ONTO TAILPIPE. ROTATE PIPE TILL IT IS LEVEL. USE CLAMP #F TO SECURE PIPE. DO NOT TIGHTEN.



INSTALL STAINLESS TIP.
USE ANY ALUMINUM OR
STAINLESS CLEANER TO
POLISH YOUR TIP. TIGHTEN
ALL NUTS, BOLTS & CLAMPS.



SLIDE MUFFLER # B ONTO HEADPIPE AT LEAST 1"- 2" WITH INLET TOWARDS THE MOTOR. OUTLET SHOULD BE AT 9 O'CLOCK POSITION. INLET OF MUFFLER IS LOOKING INTO THE LOUVERS. USE A JACKSTAND TO SUPPORT THE MUFFLER.



MAKE SURE YOU HAVE A 1" CLEARANCE ON ALL PIPES FROM ALL RUBBER BRAKE LINES, FUEL LINES, SHOCK BOOTS, TIRES, ETC
